To the Membership of St. John's Lutheran Church of Erie,

The Old Testament passage above is literally my favorite Bible verse. It gives me hope in all things. I lead off this letter with that statement of faith as a reminder to us all. I write to you with both gratitude and sadness to announce that the end of my time at St. John's Lutheran Church of Erie has come, effective Sunday, May 7<sup>th</sup>. It is with a heavy heart that I recognize that my last Sunday with you has already come to pass.

As I have said more than once: It is humbling to walk down "Heritage Hall," looking at all of the clergy who have come before me and their service within their allotted time here. I am grateful for having had the opportunity to continue the stewardship of the pulpit and altar in this place with them – the opportunity to be part of the story of this church. Walking that hall and reading of our story in this place is nothing if not a reminder that the Holy Spirit has set a beginning and end time for everything under heaven – my time here included.

This is not a decision that I ever wanted to have to make. Yet the Holy Spirit has made it abundantly clear that I have done as much as is within my power for this congregation and that it is now time for me to move on to where the Spirit is leading next. That "next" for me is thus: I have received and accepted the Call from St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Erie to be their Senior Pastor. I will be taking a few weeks off to properly transition myself between calls.

For 215 years the gospel has been preached and the sacraments have been shared in this congregation's midst. It is my hope and prayer for you all that a Pentecost (Acts 2:1-4) sweep through this building and invigorate you toward a transformed calling and a renewed mission, that another 215 years of the Great Commission as directed by Jesus in Matthew 28:18-20 be done in and through the people and means of St. John's.
